Childhood Immunization Schedule

The vaccines recommended at each well-child visit, based on the American Academy of Pediatrics 2026 immunization schedule.

Birth	HepB
1–2 months	HepB
2 months	DTaP Hib PCV IPV RV
4 months	DTaP Hib PCV IPV RV
6 months	DTaP Hib PCV IPV RV HepB Influenza COVID-19
12–15 months	Hib PCV MMR Varicella HepA
15–18 months	DTaP
18–24 months	HepA – 2nd dose, 6 months after the 1st
4–6 years	DTaP IPV MMR Varicella
11–12 years	Tdap HPV (2 doses) MenACWY
16 years	MenACWY booster MenB (for some teens, 16–18)

Every year & in season. Influenza yearly for everyone 6 months and older · RSV one dose for infants during RSV season · COVID-19 as recommended for your child’s age.

WHAT THE ABBREVIATIONS MEAN

HepB – Hepatitis B

Hib – *H. influenzae* type b

MMR – Measles, Mumps, Rubella

RSV – Respiratory Syncytial Virus

MenACWY – Meningococcal ACWY

RV – Rotavirus

PCV – Pneumococcal

Varicella – Chickenpox

Tdap – Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis

MenB – Meningococcal B

DTaP – Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis

IPV – Polio

HepA – Hepatitis A

HPV – Human Papillomavirus

Influenza – Flu
